

## "SCHOLARSHIP 2021"



The Scholarship covers 100% of the tuition fee. This program is designed for students who want to learn Spanish language in as short a time as possible. This course is recommended for serious students who want to make the most of their time abroad to achieve a good language level in Spanish. **This is a very intense program and students have to study hard and do homework every day, so please make sure you understand this well.** The program emphasizes what students can do with language rather than simply what they know about it.

### Spanish & Culture

Our objective for students is to learn the language and to use it with confidence. Various learning practices (oral and written expression, listening comprehension, audio and video materials, text reading, etc.) and focus on interactive communication will advance your improvement. You will not only learn Spanish effectively, but gain knowledge on the social, cultural and political life in Argentina.

### SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL INFORMATION

**Duration:** 2 weeks.

**Hours per day:** 6 classes of 55 minutes each

**Levels:** A1-A2-B1.

**Time schedule:** from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. // from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**Requirements:** Age range: 16 to 26. Beginner-Intermediate Spanish levels: A1-A2 or B1

**Optional University Credits:** students can obtain 3 university credits for their Spanish studies in Córdoba. They have to pass a final exam and this allows them to obtain a certificate which in turn can be transformed into university credits in their home country. (See terms and conditions N° 5)

**Cost:** The scholarship covers the tuition fee

## METHODOLOGY

In order to make best use of all the productive and helpful aspects of the different Spanish teaching methods currently en vogue, Onix-Intercambio Cultural has developed an approach that selectively picks the most valuable elements of each. Our objective is to take full advantage of the different pedagogical principles for Spanish language education. This way, our methodology combines the latest strategies and methods (process and communicative approaches) with the more traditional ones that have proven to be efficient over many years (formal and functional approaches).

Our selective methodology was developed to meet the requirements of learning Spanish in an immersion context, and is based on the specifications proposed by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. This comprehensive teaching method allows students to develop simultaneously and in a harmonic way all the foreign language learning skills (speaking, listening, reading and writing), together with strategic skills. This way, it facilitates the integration of the students' different learning styles and abilities. Our experience shows that this approach is significantly enhancing our students' progress in acquiring content and developing language skills.

Indeed, learning a language is not only about learning grammar and vocabulary, but requires students to be able to put into practise their knowledge in different real-life situations. This also motivates our choice to integrate specific cultural contents (particularly the Argentine and Latin-American one) into the learning process. Communication requires knowing more than simply the structure of a language: it requires implicit knowledge of the cultural context in which interactions take place.

## CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

It would be a shame if we “only” taught you the Spanish language and neglected Argentina’s and Latin-America’s artistic, historic and literary legacy. At Onix-Intercambio Cultural, we believe that language and culture go hand in hand. This is why we have designed programs rich in cultural content, the degree of which varies according to the duration of your specific program and skill level. These activities form an integral part of our teaching methodology to ensure that our students gain true insights and get answers about our history and culture.

Every Monday we propose our students a list of at least four weekly events, including academic activities and upcoming city programs.

You will develop and deliver an oral presentation by yourself or with other students, and to answer questions from the audience about your presentation.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Elegibility

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Age range: 16 to 26.
- Beginner/Intermediate Spanish Levels: A1-A2 or B1

### How are scholarship recipients chosen?

**Euro Club de Córdoba, Club de Derecho de Córdoba y el Instituto Argentino de Cultura**

Our selection committee (integrated by one member of each 3 institutions) takes many factors into consideration when choosing scholarship candidates. Scholarships are awarded to those who demonstrate a commitment to their communities, volunteer work and a genuine interest in cultural programs.

**Preference may be given to:** Applicants Résumé, Spanish language level and volunteer work.

### General Considerations

1. Students are responsible for observing the legal provisions applicable to enter and leave Argentina.
2. Personal expenses arising out of or related to the student's stay in Argentina are not included in the scholarship.
3. **Student is responsible for purchasing a comprehensive international health insurance policy to cover health care costs during the visit to Argentina.** Students release and forever discharge Onix-Intercambio Cultural Foundation from any and all liability whatsoever for medical attention and medical expenses during that period.
4. Students personally assume all risks, whether foreseen or unforeseen, for any harm, injury or damage that may befall them during their visit to Argentina. They are also fully responsible for their luggage and personal property entirely throughout their trip. Students release and forever discharge Onix-Intercambio Cultural Foundation from any and all liability whatsoever for any direct or consequential loss, injury or damage arising from any of the aforementioned situations.
5. **Optional University Credits:** students can obtain 3 university credits for their Spanish studies in Córdoba. They have to pass a final exam and this allows them to obtain a certificate which in turn can be transformed into university credits in their home country. The exam has a cost of USD 45.
6. All scholarship recipients are responsible for their own airfare, airport transfer, accommodation, health travel insurance and daily living expenses.
7. **Reduction of Spanish Lesson:** Onix-Intercambio Cultural Foundation reserves the right to reduce the number of lessons in a class with **less than 3 students**. If there are 2 students in a class, lessons will be reduced by 50%. If there is 1 student in a class, lessons will be reduced by 60%.  
**(20 group lessons = 10 two-to-one lessons = 8 one-on-one lessons)**
